

Application for Readmission

APPLICATION FOR READMISSION

Degree students who have failed to register for four or more semesters must apply for readmission using this application. If readmitted, students must pay a readmission fee equivalent to maintenance of status for four semesters (according to the fee schedules for the four semesters immediately preceding enrollment), plus tuition or maintenance of status fees for the current semester. They must also pay university and divisional fees for the current semester. Readmitted students are not exempt from time-limit requirements. Readmission of students who have exceeded the time limit (five years for the MA or MS, ten years for the PhD, and twelve years for the PhD in Clinical Psychology) is subject to approval by the dean.

READMISSION PROCEDURE

Application Form

File the completed application form with the The New School for Social Research Admission Office.

Recommendation

One recommendation is required. An "Applicant's Letter of Recommendation" form must be downloaded from the NSSR website, completed by the applicant, and given to the recommender. The person writing the recommendation should be a faculty member in your New School for Social Research degree program or someone else qualified to comment on the merits of your academic work and your qualifications for reentering a New School for Social Research degree program.

Application Fee

A nonrefundable application fee of \$50.00 must accompany your completed application form. Applications will not be processed without this fee. Payment may be made by check, payable to The New School; or by credit card, using the enclosed Credit Card Authorization form.

Credentials

An official transcript from each institution the applicant has attended since the last registration at The New School for Social Research is required. Only official transcripts sent directly to The New School for Social Research Admission Office by the issuing institution will be accepted. Applicants must supply certified English translations of all credentials that are not in English.

Statement of Objectives and Goals

Attach a one- to three-page statement of your educational objectives and career goals. You should indicate why you left the school and why you have now decided to apply for readmission. Please comment on any academic work undertaken since your last registration, and outline your plans for completion of the degree. If your recent experience has been other than academic, describe it briefly, indicating its relation to your decision to reapply.

Deadline

Applicants who wish to be considered for full fellowships must submit their completed applications by January 15. All applications completed by January 15 will be processed by mid-March. Applications received or completed after January 15 will be considered for admission and partial tuition scholarships on a rolling basis. An application is not considered complete until all required documents have been received by the Office of Admission. The deadline for application for fall admission is August 1; international applicants should apply no later than July 1 to allow sufficient time for visa application. The deadline for application for spring admission is October 15. Spring entry is an option for all programs.
