For the minor in French Studies, students must complete at least six (6) courses: four core courses and two electives. Students already proficient in French may, upon the recommendation of the French section coordinator, substitute elective courses for one or both advanced language courses. Students who go on a Study Abroad program with partner institutions such as The American University of Paris may use some of the AUP courses to fulfill the French Studies Minor requirements. Students must earn a grade of C or higher for the course to count toward the minor. Students should consult an advisor when selecting coursework.
