Exams and final projects can be delivered in English. For this reason, exchange students are expected to have a good level of English. Exchange students coming to Iceland Academy of the Arts can apply for an Intensive Icelandic Language Course (EILC), which is held in August every year. Deadline for applications is May 31, 2013. Other international students can apply for this course as well, with the additional cost of about 500,
