Orientation RSVP and Workshop Selection:

Incoming students and families must RSVP for Orientation through RegPack. This free registration system will ask you to create a username and password, which will allow you to register for events throughout Orientation Week and Welcome Week(end). Use the instructions on the following pages to select your required workshops, and take your time reading the workshop descriptions to dive into all The New School has to offer!

Orientation Check-In and Final Schedule:

Your RSVP and workshop selection on RegPack is one part to complete your registration for Orientation. Be sure to complete your new student checklist items on MyNewSchool, and complete the required modules on Prep for Success pre-orientation online course. When you arrive to campus, you must sign in at the Orientation Check-In desk. At check-in, you will receive your printed, finalized schedule and your welcome kit. **You can find the check-in table in the Event Café (UL103) of the University Center**, 63 Fifth Avenue. International Students

International Student Check-In

All international students, professors, and scholars must officially check in with ISSS within **ten days of arriving** in the United States during the first semester of their program. New students and scholars must complete the online check-in form in their <u>iGlobal</u> page. All new students and scholars must upload their immigration documents (I-20/DS-2019, passport, and printout of their electronic <u>94</u> card). This check-in is in addition to your Orientation Check-In or your School-Based Check-In.

New International Student Orientation

Attendance at the in-person New International Student Orientation is required by both The New School and the U.S. government. During this session, you will learn your rights and responsibilities while in F-1 or J-1 status, learn more about the ISSS office, and meet other international students. Information about the date and location of the New International Student Orientation is included in the welcome letter that was mailed to you along with your I-20 or DS-2019.
