#### Immunization Clinic

Monday-Friday: 10:00 AM - 4:30 PM

New York State law requires that matriculated students born on or after 1957 document their immunization against measles, mumps, and rubella. New York State law also requires documentation of your meningitis vaccine, or that you will receive the vaccine within 30 days, or that you decline the vaccine.

All students must demonstrate that they have read the material distributed by the university on meningococcal disease, and either plan to receive the meningitis vaccination (Menactra, Menomune), have documentation proving receipt of the vaccination within the last five years, or decline receipt of the same. Please note that this immunization is not required but is strongly recommended.
