

Step 1. Contact Prescription Solutions by OptumRx

Step 2. Move your prescription to Prescription Solutions by OptumRx

Prescription Solutions by OptumRx will help you transfer your active specialty prescriptions from your current pharmacy. If you are out of refills, Prescription Solutions by OptumRx will contact your doctor to get a new prescription and can help answer any questions you may have.
