

THE ARTS REQUIREMENTS

TRACK: ARTS IN CONTEXT

The Arts in Context track is intended for students wishing to create an integrated program situating one of the arts within the context of another academic discipline, such as literature, politics or sociology. Courses are chosen in consultation with the faculty advisor. A **written path statement** explaining the student's intended curriculum and rationale are required.

Students must earn a grade of C or higher in all course requirements for the area of study in The Arts.
