We are interested in migrant experiences of journey and exile that include but are not limited to: mistranslations, loss and longing, homesickness, hopes and dreams, isolation and solidarities, borders and bureaucracies. You can be poetic, political, narrative, comic, experimental. You can be personal or abstract, global or local, inspiring or polemical.

Format: Quicktime. We are looking for a diversity of approaches: animation, video or digital film, photo stories, performance, silent or with sound, Etc.

Length: 15 seconds – 3 minutes.
