- GOREMAL Person E-mail repeating table

- SPBPERS Basic Person Base Table

Key attributes:

The key attributes of this view are:

- Personal ID Master PIDM_KEY

Since the PIDM is an internal ID number unique to each student, the view returns one row of information for each student.
