INSTRUCTIONS

- All applicants are required to apply online. Save your work frequently and print a copy for your records. You must complete all required fields and uploads prior to submission.
- Any additional supporting documents that need to be sent by mail must include an Application Materials Cover Sheet, which can be found at www.newschool.edu/admission/coversheet/mannes/. All supporting materials must be received before your application can be reviewed.
- Applicants for the Master of Music degree must have completed a bachelor's degree or its equivalent upon enrollment. Professional Studies Diploma applicants must have completed a bachelor's degree or conservatory diploma; however, a master's degree is recommended.

APPLICATION

APPLICATION FEE

A non-refundable \$100 application fee paid as part of the online application. Applicants who wish to audition for two concentrations must pay a second \$100 application fee.

OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS

Undergraduates: All applicants must provide official high school and/or college transcripts. If you are currently in school, submit transcripts for all coursework taken to date. Applicants who have attended multiple high schools may submit only the graduating school's official transcript as long as all prior coursework is reflected on that transcript.

Graduates: Official Transcripts must be provided for every undergraduate or graduate institution attended for course credit. We will expect an official transcript from each institution listed in the Academic History section of the application. Although not required, an unofficial copy of your transcript(s) may be uploaded with your application.

Transfer Applicants: Transfer applicants who have completed fewer than 24 college credits (on a semester system) must submit high school transcript(s) in addition to college transcripts. Credits for music courses taken elsewhere are not automatically transferable, though credit may be given towards a Mannes degree pending the results of the entrance test, interview, and transcript evaluation.

By Mail: Official transcripts should have an original signature or a raised university seal, and must be in a sealed envelope that has been signed or stamped by the issuing university's registrar or records office. Applicants may send official transcripts with an Application Materials Cover Sheet, or applicants can request that institutions send transcripts directly to The New School. See "Mailing Address for Supplemental Materials" for mailing address.

Electronic Transcripts (U.S./Domestic Institutions only): The New School accepts electronic transcripts only from our approved vendors. The New School's approved vendors in order of preference are:

APPLICATION STATUS

Applications become complete and ready for review once all required items have been received by the Office of Admission. You may check your application status online at the Admission Hub.

Allow at least 14 days from the date you submitted your application for items to be matched and shown as received on the Hub. Applicants are responsible for following up with schools and recommenders to confirm that items have been sent.

The Office of Admission will periodically notify applicants by email if their file is missing any documents and again when their file is complete for review. These notifications are sent to the email address provided in the online application.

APPLYING FOR FINANCIAL AID OR SCHOLARSHIP

All applicants admissible into our program are considered for a merit scholarship award that is determined by the strength of their application. Scholarship award notification is communicated at the same time as the admission decision. International Students are only eligible for merit scholarships. If you are a U.S. Citizen, or eligible non-citizen, we encourage you to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) which can be found on the web at www.fafsa.gov. The FAFSA is available each year on January 1. You do not need to wait for an admission decision to apply for federal aid; we recommend submitting by our FAFSA priority deadlines:

Fall: March 1
Spring: November 1

We do not accept electronic transcripts sent directly by a student or school offices. **Note:** All international academic credentials must be submitted as indicated in the International Academic Credentials sections below.

High School Equivalency: For GED, TASC, and HiSET, send official test score results via postal mail.

Home Schooling: Home school applicants must provide the equivalent of a high school transcript with course or subject titles, duration of study for each title, content of study for each tile, and an assessment of performance or “grade.” Preferably, the courses completed at home are part of a curriculum developed and evaluated by a nationally recognized diploma granting organization or agency. If not connected with such an organization, home school applicants must obtain and submit a GED as confirmation of completing a generally acceptable secondary school curriculum. If an official transcript from a state home school association or sponsoring public high school is not available, home school students must submit an equivalency or GED, TASC, or HiSET exam results. Individual home school transcripts with date of completion do not suffice as official proof of graduation.

International Academic Credentials: All transcripts not written in English must be accompanied by a certified English translation.

International Academic Credentials with Transfer Credits: Applicants who attended post secondary institutions outside of the US are required to have their transcript(s) evaluated by World Education Services (WES), our preferred provider, or by another member of the National Association of Credit Evaluation Services (NACES). A course-by-course evaluation must be prepared for each transcript. In the absence of an evaluation, the Admissions Committee will do their best to render a decision. Please note, in some cases a review cannot be made without an evaluation and a committee decision will be delayed.

If using WES, visit www.wes.org for instructions and to begin the application process. The “Required Documents” section will explain what to send. If you request your report online, search for “New School Mannes” when selecting our institution. WES will send your completed evaluation directly to The New School.

If using another NACES provider, follow instructions for that provider. Mailed evaluations and translations should be sent to the mailing address provided for supporting materials. Applicants forwarding these sealed documents should include an Application Materials Cover Sheet.

RECOMMENDATION LETTERS

Two letters of recommendation are required. The first should be written by a recent music teacher or professional musician and should focus on the applicant’s talent and performance ability. The second should be written by a teacher or guidance counselor who is familiar with the applicant’s academic aptitude. Recommenders may submit recommendations online, and instructions are included with the online application. If preferred, the recommendation form may instead be sent by mail in a signed, sealed envelope. To send by mail, download the PDF recommendation form found in the online application, complete personal information, save the form, and forward to recommender for completion and submission. Applicants may also send signed and sealed recommendations to the Office of Admission using an Application Materials Cover Sheet.

PERSONAL STATEMENT

In prose form and in 200-500 words, please choose one of the following questions to answer.

Please do not input resume or curriculum vitae in this area:

Choice 1: Describe the biggest risk you’ve ever taken.

Choice 2: Why did you decide to pursue music as a career?

Choice 3: If you had to pick the perfect admission essay question, what would it be, and how would you answer it?

Choice 4: Please describe in detail your interest in music improvisation, new music technologies, music entrepreneurship and/or public engagement. Please also describe how you feel music education can help you pursue your career goals in these areas.

PRESCREENING (if applicable)

In order to be considered for a live audition, applicants for piano, violin, cello, flute, and voice concentrations must submit a prescreening recording. Applicants for the composition concentration must submit scores for review. Please see the “Auditions” page at www.newschool.edu/mannes for details. You must submit prescreening materials electronically using Accepted at <https://app.getacceptd.com/mannes> when you apply online. Prescreening recordings must be submitted with the application by the November 1 Spring term application deadline or the December 1 Fall term

application deadline. Mannes College Division and Mannes Preparatory Honors program students are exempt from the prescreening requirement. Current Mannes students in all divisions applying for a new or different program will have the application fee waived if they contact the Office of Admission before December 1.

LIVE AUDITIONS

Live auditions (on campus and regional) in Cello, Composition, Flute, Piano, Violin, and Voice require submission of prescreening recordings at <https://app.getacceptd.com/mannes>. Auditions in these areas will be confirmed after review of the submitted prescreening recordings. Prescreening recordings must be received by the application deadline of December 1 (April 1 for Late Review). Prescreening recordings received after this deadline will be reviewed at the discretion of the Admissions Office. Mannes accepts auditions in three different formats. Personal auditions are encouraged of all applicants.

- Regional Audition: Regional auditions are offered at sites in Asia, Europe, and other sites during the month of January and February. The auditions are audio and video recorded then brought back to campus for the faculty to evaluate. Please note that regional auditions are not available for orchestral conducting or spring enrollment. ENGLISH PLACEMENT EXAM

All applicants whose first language is not English are required to take the Mannes English Placement Test, which assesses an applicant's reading comprehension, writing ability, and verbal communication skills.

TEST SCORES

SAT and ACT: Though SAT and ACT test scores are NOT required for admission, we will accept them as a supplementary credential. The institution code for these tests is 7336. Home school applicants must submit standardized test scores from either the SAT or ACT. Home school applicants may submit two standardized subject test results in lieu of the SAT.

TOEFL, IELTS, and PTE: All applicants whose first language is not English must submit valid TOEFL, IELTS, or PTE scores. Our TOEFL institution code is 2398.

The TOEFL/IELTS/PTE requirement may be waived for applicants who have earned a 4-year degree from a U.S. College or University, or for citizens of the following countries whose native language is also English: England, Scotland, Wales, Ireland, Australia, New Zealand, Canada, South Africa, or Common Wealth Caribbean (Antigua and Barbuda, Bahamas, Barbados, Belize, Dominica, Grenada, Guyana, Jamaica, St. Kitts and Nevis, St. Lucia, St. Vincent and Grenadines, and Trinidad and Tobago).

Arrange for the testing service to send your test scores directly to The New School using the institution codes listed above. We accept scores taken within the past two years. If your scores are older, you must retake the test.

Current Mannes students whose first language is not English; who are enrolled in the Extension Division diploma program, the professional studies diploma program, or the undergraduate diploma program; and who are applying for admission to the bachelor of music, bachelor of science, or master of music degree program are required to submit TOEFL, IELTS, or PTE scores and take the Mannes English Placement Exam.

Current Mannes students enrolled in the bachelor of music, bachelor of science, or master of music programs who apply for a new program are not required to submit TOEFL, IELTS, or PTE scores nor take the Mannes English Placement Exam.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS

APPLYING TO MORE THAN ONE PROGRAM

In any given term, a student may apply to only ONE department or program within The New School. Applicants who file more than one application in a given semester will be required to withdraw one of the applications, and application fees will NOT be refunded.

APPLICATION MATERIALS

All materials submitted in association with The New School application become the property of The New School and cannot be returned to you or transmitted to a third party.

ADVANCED LEVEL CREDIT

Undergraduate AP, IB, and A-Level Courses: Accepted applicants will receive further instructions later in the process regarding AP, IB, and A-Level scores.

HOME SCHOOL APPLICANTS

The New School welcomes applications from home schooled students. The Admission Committee does not require advanced preparation in every academic area, but applicants should demonstrate substantial work in English, history, social studies, foreign language, mathematics, and science.
