## VISITING STUDENT GRADUATE PROGRAMS APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Applicants intending to become visiting students at Parsons can apply to the master's degree programs. Admission as a visiting student is decided upon review of all required application materials and the availability of space in the program. Upon acceptance, students may enroll in our degree program courses for one or two academic terms.

Visiting students must be enrolled in a full-time degree program to apply. Parsons is not responsible for guaranteeing transferability of credits back to the applicant's home institution.

The application deadline for the fall term (September–December) is April 1. The application deadline for the spring term (January–May) is October 1. Late applications may be considered on a rolling basis pending space availability.

#### **Application Requirements**

Visiting students are required to follow the same application instructions as all other degree-seeking students. Instead of submitting an online application, please submit the Visiting Student paper application. The decision to admit applicants is always contingent upon their successful completion of any current studies and the receipt of the final transcripts by the Office of Graduate Admission.
