U.S. Citizens and Permanent Residents

If you are a U.S. citizen or permanent resident and are interested in applying for Federal Work-Study, you must file, in addition to the Application for Financial Aid and Scholarship Support for New Students, the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), which is available on the Web at www.fafsa.ed.gov and in the University Financial Aid Office. The New School Title IV code is 002780. The FAFSA must be submitted with the application for admission to allow sufficient processing time. A processed FAFSA is called a Student Aid Report (SAR). In order to be considered for need-based aid, you must include the Title IV code on your FAFSA to ensure that your SAR information is electronically transferred to the university.

International Students

International applicants for financial aid are required to submit only this Application for Financial Aid and Scholarship Support. They are not required to submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid.
