Student Timeline Guide for Success**

SPRING 2009: RESEARCH & DECIDE

- Attend information session on campus or at IIE/Fulbright
- Visit www.fulbrightonline.org to review application process
- Contact beatonh@newschool.edu with questions about the application process
- Contact your Fulbright Program Advisor (FPA) with questions about your specific project
- Research overseas university systems and study opportunities
- Consult your network of academic advisors and professors
- Determine if host country affiliation is needed
- Make your decision as to whether or not to apply
- (Fulbright Grants, if awarded, cannot be deferred to a different academic year)

SUMMER 2009: PREPARE YOUR APPLICATION

- Assemble application. Application is available online at www.fulbrightonline.org
- Submit draft of essay, CV, and transcript to your Fulbright Program Advisor (FPA)
- Contact potential recommenders, including language evaluator if needed
- Request official, sealed academic transcripts from all institutions you attended
- Secure host country affiliation, if needed
- Review and revise application materials
- Send recommenders reference forms and drafts of essays and Curriculum Vitae
- Submit draft of application materials for comments, critique
- Final revisions

Summer 2009: 'Priority' deadlines - These are not required but highly recommended:

July 1, 2009	Set up profile in Online Application
August 1, 2009	Submit draft of proposal to FPA including proposed affiliations

Fall 2008: Deadlines:

Sept 11, 2009	Last Day to submit proposals for comments and critique
Sept 25, 2009	The New school IIE Fulbright Campus Deadline
Sept 28 – Oct 9	The New School conducts campus interviews and makes recommendations.
Oct 12 – Oct 15	All applications are copied, reviewed, & sent to IIE by The New School's International Student Services office
Oct 19, 2009	IIE Fulbright National Deadline (on-line application)
Oct 21, 2009	IIE Fulbright National Deadline (hard copy application)
