Undergraduate students from any division of The New School may select a **minor** in The Arts at Eugene Lang College. (Students pursuing a self-designed BA in Liberal Arts may not select an academic minor.)

Lang Arts majors may select any minor of their choice (including an Arts minor different from their major area of study) and are allowed to double-count one course towards their major/minor combination. Transfer students are allowed to count up to 2 transfer courses towards the minor, and these courses are subject to approval by the area program director.
