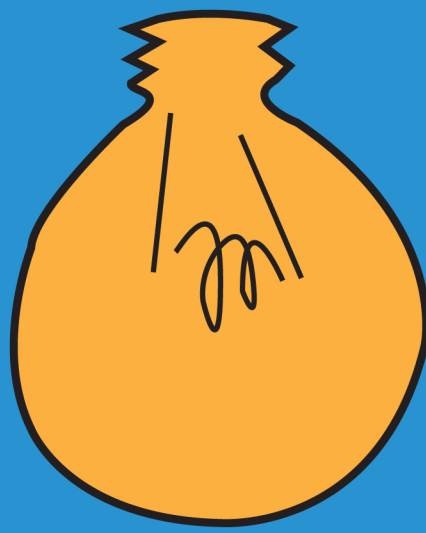


Turn off the water.

\$3.9 million a year on electricity.

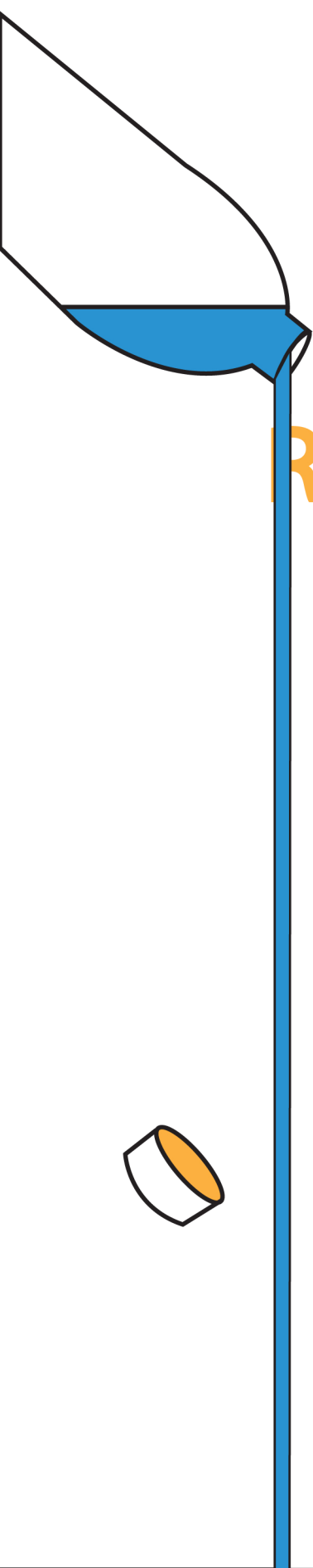
Take the stairs.

plastic waste.**

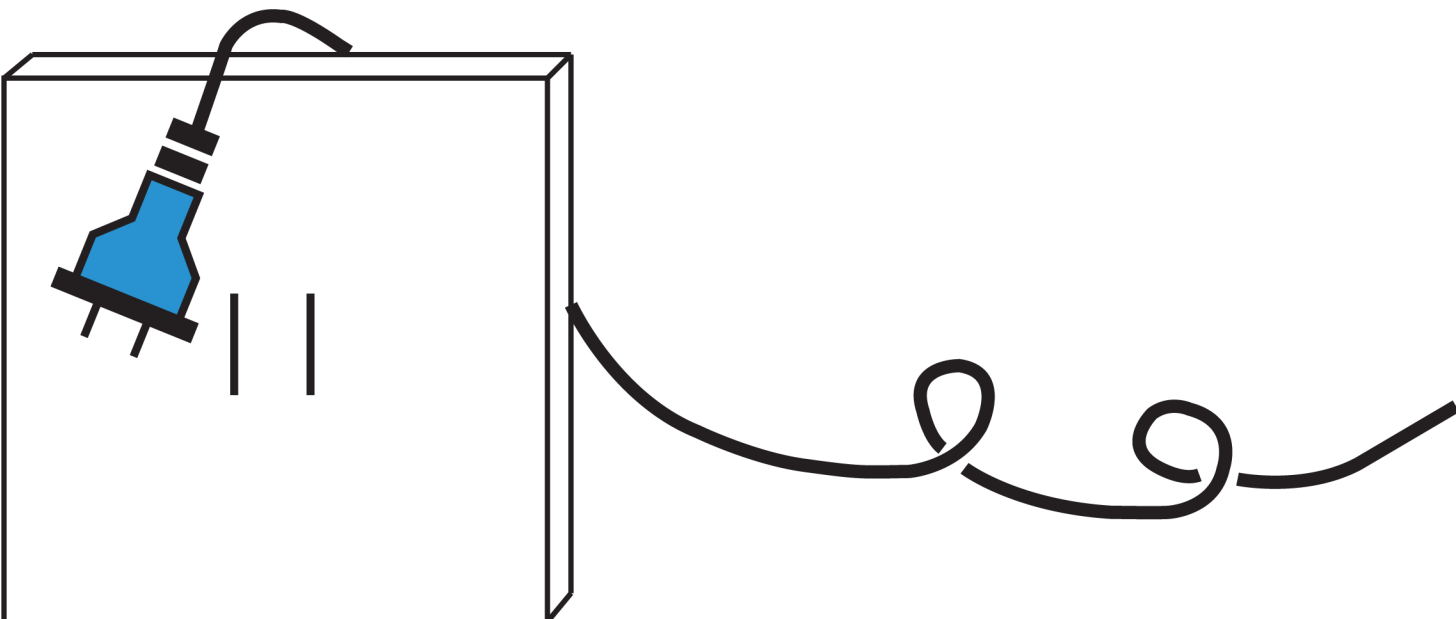
Fewer than 30%
